

COMMUNITY INFORMATION SESSION FOR PROPOSED ALTERNATE ROUTE ACROSS NIPIGON RIVER



The Employment Counselor under the direction of Chief and Council will primarily be responsible for assisting members of the Red Rock Indian Band achieve their career goals by helping with job search strategies, resume writing, and preparing for job interviews. The Employment Counselor will also be responsible for helping Red Rock Indian Band members plan for transitions into new careers, by identifying their interests and helping to create a plan to map out the process. Interested applicants should meet the following requirements:

- High School Diploma or GED.
- College Diploma, or University Degree in Education, Human/Social Science, or Psychology (Preferred)
- Minimum of 1-year experience in Counseling or Human/Social Services
- High level of personal integrity.
- Professional/mature demeanor under stressful situations.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment.
- Confident, consistent decisive personality.
- Must be able to work with little supervision; must be self-directed.



ATTENTION TRAPPERS

The Head Trapper of trapline NG-111, located up the Camp 81 Road, northwest of Kabamichigama Lake, has submitted a recommendation to transfer the trapline to the helper trapper. See map below.



First Nations have the right of first refusal when a registered trap line becomes vacant. One condition for this is to establish and document a "significant traditional family connection" to the trap line. Anyone with a family connection to this trap line or the general area of the trap line is encouraged contact the Lands and Resources Department of the RRIB as soon as possible and before March 2nd, 2018.
