On Monday May 13, 2019 Toby Braithwaite, Management Biologist from MNRF, Nipigon Region and Environmental Monitor and Elder Tom Borg from the Red Rock Indian Band presented a Fish Conservation presentation to the Grade 7/8 Native Language and Culture students at St Edward School. From a Scientific perspective and a Traditional Ecological Knowledge perspective (TEK) the students learned various ways of recording and collecting fish population data for the purpose of the conservation of our fish species in many of our local lakes and rivers.


