2. Would this be a salary or hourly? Would this have benefits or anything that goes with employment?

Answers:

Positions will be for the different projects, no concrete dates have been outlined, we are just getting our stuff together to maximize our opportunities for employment for our members. There are also potential renewable energy projects (battery storage and wind) that may come to fruition and other projects as well.

A General Contractor (GC) will need to be hired, and we will only be starting the EA here in the next few months. Once we decide on a GC then we negotiate the assets we have, so you could work directly under the GC, for a subcontractor through the GC, one of our JV's, or member owned business or could even be through RRIB.
